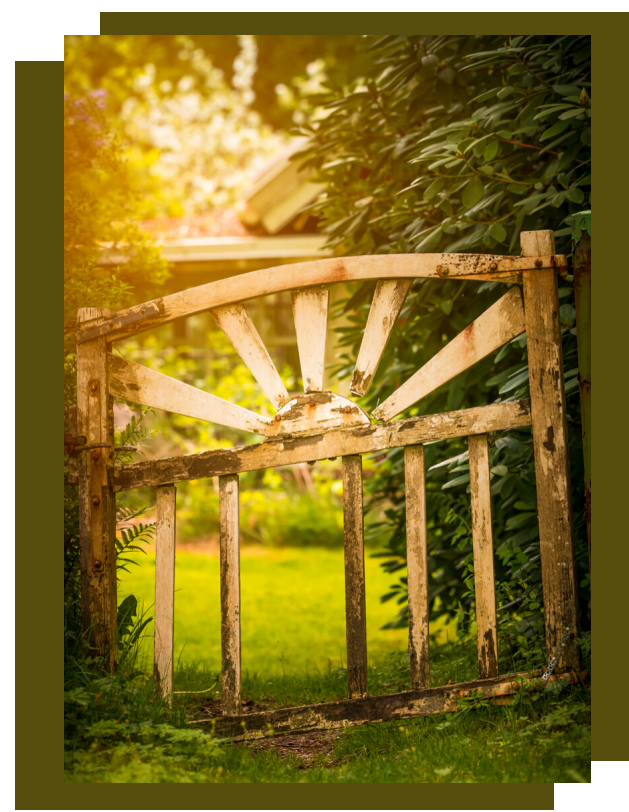


Shyness and Introversion: Love's Barricades
