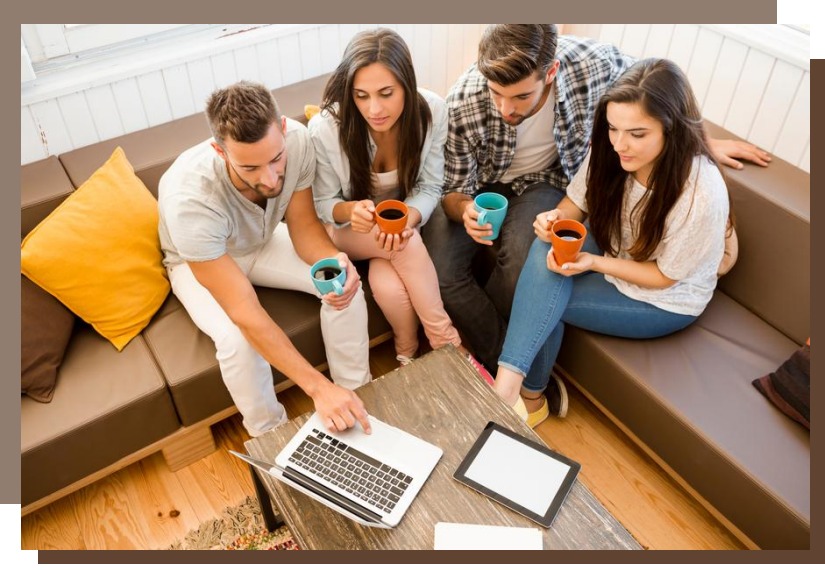

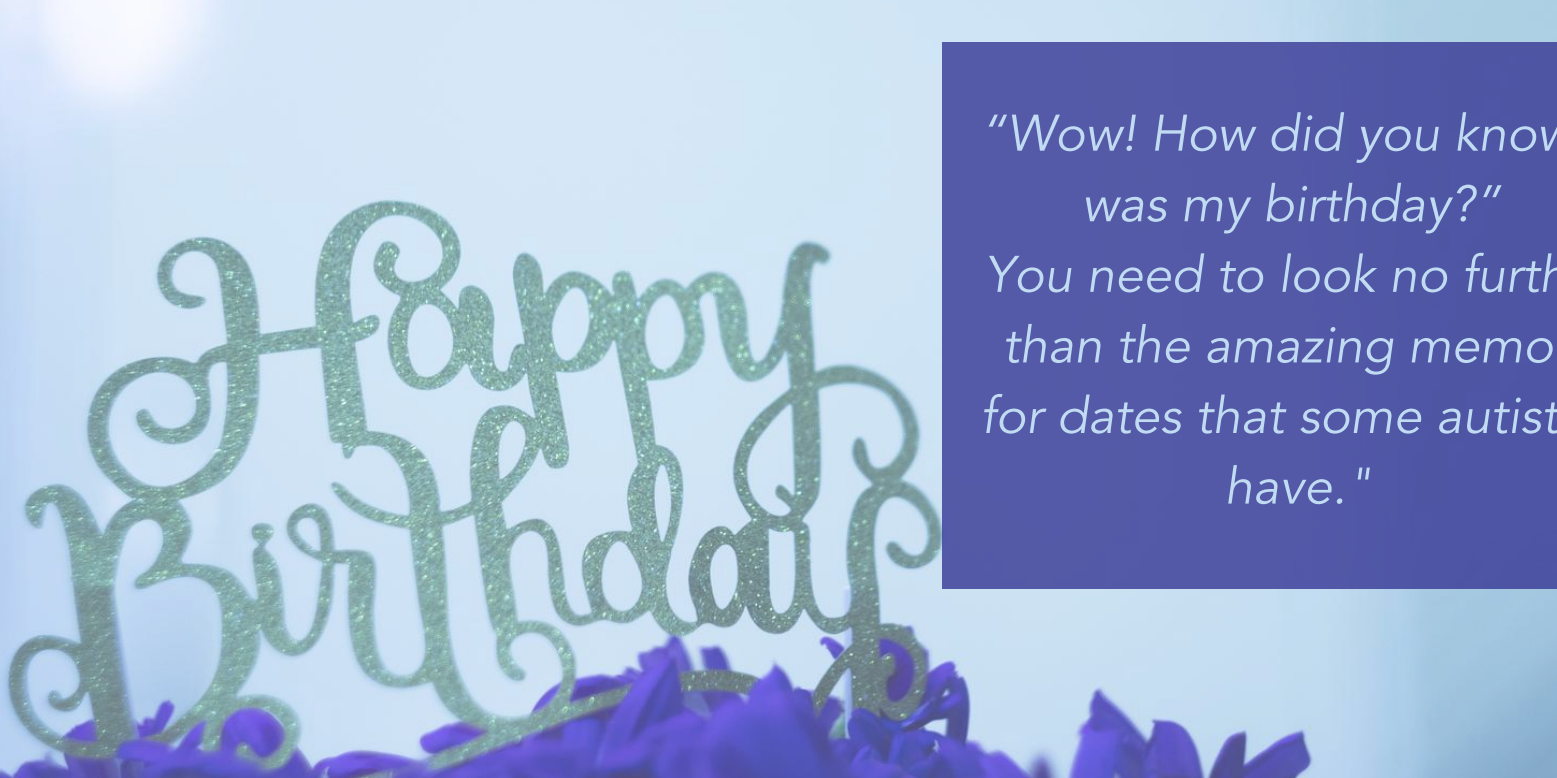
"Some negative reactions I have gotten from others include "You don't seem autistic you're so smart." Or "it's hard for me to be around autistics. I don't understand them".

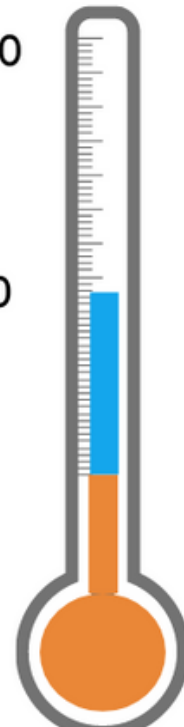
